Introduction

The RHN is a charity, independent from the NHS but working closely with it, to provide the best possible care for people living with neuro-disability.

Their specialist services support people in dedicated environments designed to best meet their needs.



The Project

The neuro-behavioural service (Wellesley ward) is a specialist inpatient ward for adults with challenging behaviour resulting from a brain injury. The work done there is crucial, however the ward itself has not been refurbished for a number of years.

A £1.5million appeal was launched, with the aim to modernise the ward; improving access, patient dignity and privacy, and creating extra space for a range of physical and occupational therapies.



Vistamatic

Projax Interior Ltd was key to the refurbishment, providing doors, door sets, cubicles, IPS and bespoke joinery. They were specifically instructed to supply the door sets including Vistamatic vision panels. They required bespoke ash windows with Vistamatic panels and custom joinery for this particular project.

Vistamatic provided 20no. custom Vista Max and 29no. standard Vista Max vision panels to the project. The panels were all FD30 with lever handle operation needed on one side only. Additionally 5no. Vista Slide vision panels were requested for larger viewing areas.
